COMMITTEE PURPOSE

COMMITTEE ROLE

1. To conduct an annual Western States Loan Servicing Conference, to provide technical information and training to senior clerical/first level management employees and thus maintain the professional quality of loan servicing.
2. To monitor changes in state and federal Government Regulations as they affect loan servicing functions.
3. To develop articles for the CMBA Newsletter, as necessary, providing information of interest to loan servicing personnel and to the industry in general.
4. To evaluate the format of the Western States Loan Servicing Conference each year to determine what changes, if any, would result in a better program for attendees.
5. To develop specialized seminars, when needed, on loan servicing subjects.
